The regulations...

USCIS has a lot of regulations about translations of civil document, just like the birth certificate. Here, you will find good advice from the experts about how to file your application. If you follow the tips below USCIS will probably accept the translation, if not, they might decline it, and it would be a big deal for you.

Important points!

You might have to submit certified translations for all foreign language documents. The translator must certify that she/he is competent to translate and that the translation is accurate.

The certification format should include the certifier's name, signature, address, and date of certification.

Finally, If you have any situation where you do not have a civil document, like birth certificate or marriage certificate from your home country, you may have have to visit the Department of State reciprocity website.
